

Why CONSISE?

- 2009 pandemic: seroepi protocols not ready or not standardised
- Results delayed
- Need to do better!



History

- 1st international meeting in Ottawa, Canada, in February 2011, hosted by the Public Health Agency of Canada.
- Decision to form a working group and start developing protocols –ECDC agreed to be secretariat
- 2nd international meeting in Stockholm, Sweden in December 2011, hosted by the ECDC.
- Adoption of name and logo of CONSISE
- 3rd international meeting, with a regional focus on South and East Asia, in January 2013 in Hong Kong, hosted by the University of Hong Kong.
- Publications: Laurie et al. 2012; Van Kerkhove et al. 2013

Objectives of CONSISE

- To develop generic seroepidemiologic protocols that can be used in pandemic outbreak settings
- To develop minimum list of epidemiological data for routine collection of sera
- To improve the quality of seroepidemiology laboratory testing
- To develop better ways to quickly deliver results in an epidemic or pandemic situation.
- To consider how to make serological work and seroepidemiology of influenza sustainable
- Consider future global funding options



Specific aims of this workshop

- Finalise CONSISE seroepidemiology protocol templates and question bank for field validation
- Review of laboratory assay comparisons and future work on standardisation of laboratory methods
- Discuss the role and lessons to be learned from CONSISE involvement in MERS-CoV and influenza A(H7N9)
- Involve more experts and end users in discussion of CONSISE activities
- Promote wider use of CONSISE tools and network for influenza and emerging respiratory viruses
