Appendix G: Tips for Using a Camera & Taking Photographs Successfully

Parts of the camera:

❖ View finder, lens, shutter release, flash, dial to bring up the next picture

Protecting the camera:

❖ Keep camera away from water, sand, extreme heat/cold

Taking a photograph:

- ❖ Keep fingers away from the lens and flash
- Hold steady when pressing the shutter release to take pictures to avoid blurry pictures
- ❖ Stand at least 3 feet from your subject, or it will be a blurry picture
- * Keep the sun behind you when outside
- ❖ When in doubt, use your flash

Use of creativity:

- ***** Explore different angles
- ❖ Alternate different distances from your subject
- Consider both posed and un-posed pictures
- ❖ Think about symbols of the community or culture that might be photographed
