

Appendix I: Individual Dialogue Session Guide

(Duration: 1 ½ -2 hours; Location: Convenient community location chosen by participants)

The individual dialogue session will be around the participants' photographs. It will last approximately 1½-2 hours and will be audio-tape recorded and transcribed.

- Each participant will choose 8-10 photographs to discuss (4-5 photographs related to needs & 4-5 photographs related to aspirations)
- The questioning acronym *PHOTO* will be used to contextualize the meaning of each of the participants' chosen photos.
- The acronym *PHOTO* (Hussey, 2006) asks the following:
 1. Describe your *Picture*?
 2. What is *Happening* in your picture?
 3. Why did you take a picture *Of* this?
 4. What does this picture *Tell* us about your life?
 5. How can this picture provide *Opportunities* for us to improve life (with regard
 6. to sex workers' lives in Portland, Oregon)?
- After discussing each photo in this way, using the *PHOTO* acronym, participants will be asked:
 1. Would you like to say anything else about the photograph that might not have been captured by the five questions?
 2. What is missing, if anything, from each photograph?
