
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### What can we contribute to GHN?

### What do we know?

- **Theory** Is any theory (more) relevant (than another for trials)?
- Process Map guidance on what needs to be considered, links to resources etc.
- Project-management software/Clinical Trial Management Systems (CTMS) plug in your own details
- Home-grown methods developed from various guidance documents, websites, training courses, meetings, word of mouth, trial and error
  - Integration of tools into SOPs to clarify who, what, where, when etc.
  - ICH GCP Section 8 for essential documents



#### What do we need?

- Resources/supporting info
  - Needs vary depending on complexity of trial, PM scope, no. of participants etc. (e.g. manual vs. programmed calendar/scheduling)
