- The answer – A question bank



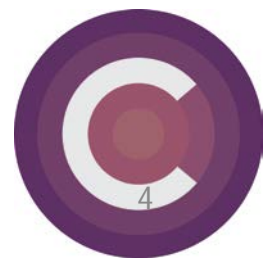
Question Bank
