- Established in 2003 as a European response to the global health crisis caused by the three main PRDs of HIV/AIDS, TB and malaria (HTM)
- Primary goal is to accelerate the development of new or improved interventions (drugs, vaccines, microbicides and diagnostics) to fight HTM
 - Through the coordination and cooperation of European national research programmes on PRDs in partnership with their African counterparts.



EDCTP Business Model







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

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


- Development of 24 selected labs in preparation for future accreditation

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

- Independent external review, impact assessment and internal consultation recommended expansion of the scope while maintaining focus
 - All phases of clinical trials (phase I-IV), but special attention to phase III
 - Include neglected infectious diseases
 - Collaboration with other DCs outside Africa when required
 - 10-year programme
- Closer collaboration with pharmaceutical industry and other like-minded organisation
