

Mission Statement

CONSISE is a global partnership aiming to standardize the seroepidemiology of influenza and other respiratory pathogens and to develop comprehensive investigation protocols for use in optimising the control of influenza and other respiratory pathogens.

Open Access

CONSISE will share study protocols and laboratory assay protocols and other information on the web with free access to all. This will help to facilitate the standardization of seroepidemiology studies on influenza and other respiratory viruses. The material will be accessible via http://consise.tghn.org.

All documents created by members for CONSISE (Consortium for the Standardization for Influenza Seroepidemiology) are distributed under the "Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike 3.0" (http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc-sa/3.0/). Users can freely copy, adapt, distribute and transmit under the conditions that: the original source is attributed; the work is not used for commercial purposes, and any altered forms of this document are distributed freely under the same conditions.

Membership will not be required to access these documents. However registration on the CONSISE website will be required to allow for an audit trail of CONSISE document use. As described above, CONSISE must be acknowledged should data originating from CONSISE protocols be used in any presentation(s) or publication(s).

Terms of Membership

- Membership is open to individuals whose activities may contribute to those of CONSISE.
- It is expected that members of CONSISE share the same CONSISE vision (see mission statement) particularly with respect to data sharing and open access.
- Membership of CONSISE is on the understanding that it is a not-for-profit organization.
- Prospective members will register their interest to the CONSISE secretariat by a registration form.
- Membership will be approved by the CONSISE Steering Committee.
- Members will be asked to register their interest in one (or both) of the two Working Groups; Epidemiology and Laboratory.
- Membership will continue unless any issue has been brought to the attention of the CONSISE Steering Committee and any member may be removed by agreement within the Steering Committee.
- Any member may resign by informing the secretariat at any time.
- Non members may participate in the activities of the Working Groups and CONSISE meetings at the discretion of the Chairs of the Epidemiology and Laboratory Working Groups.
