

Aim: Evaluate the engagement process and experiences of patients, public members and researchers within our PPIE group in order to identify barriers and facilitators to engagement.






Step 2: Develop a Terms of Reference (TOR) 16 hybrid meetings

Co-designed with the PPIE group using a participatory action research approach and an explanatory sequential mixed-method design.


