Will I be able to conduct clinical trials after the course	Students will discover best practices in global health research studies, including clinical trials - the mechanisms, methods and processes required to implement good quality, safe and ethical research, typically in low resource settings.

The course is offered part-time online and requires a commitment of up to 20 hours per week. There are 2 one-hour live lessons a week, and group work as determined within your group. The rest of the content and tasks can be studied flexibly in your own time.
