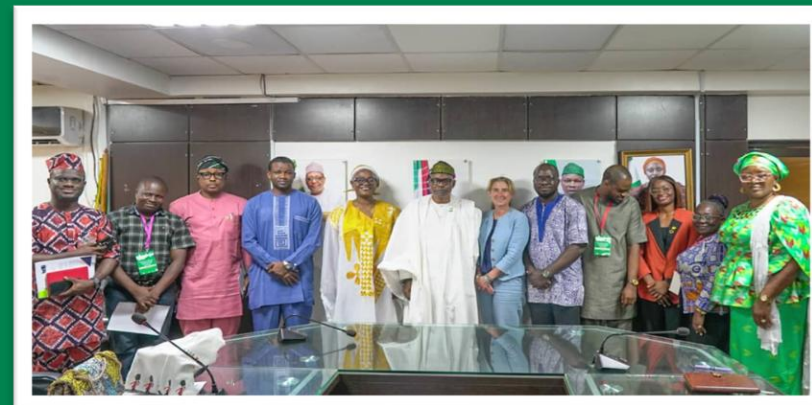
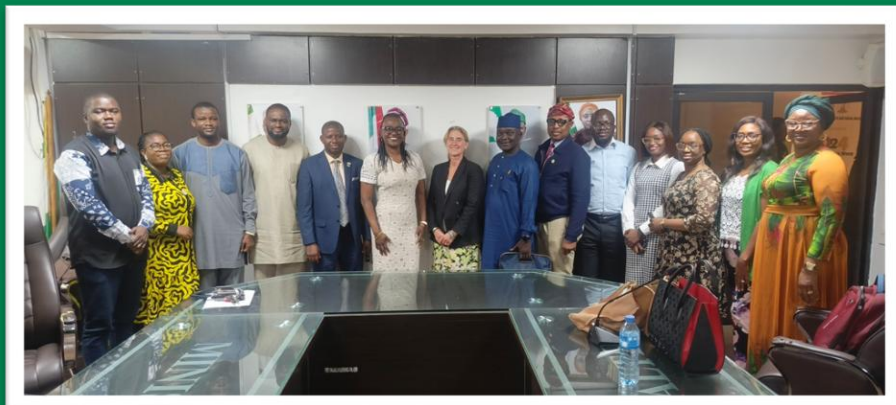

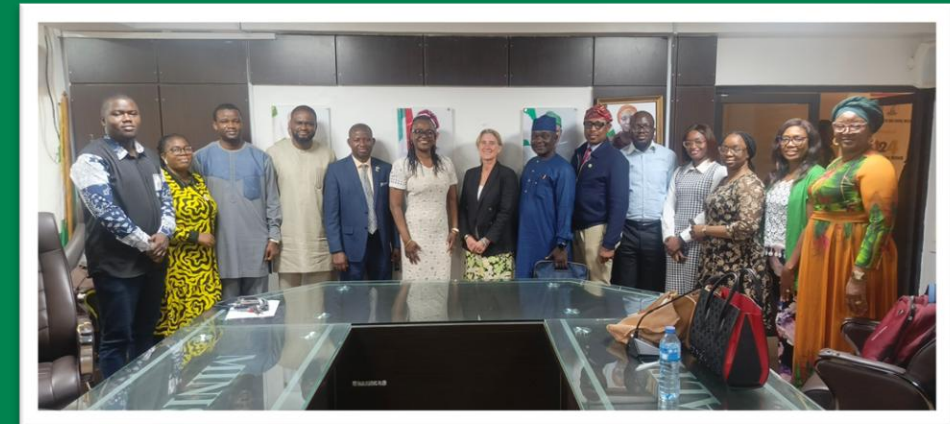

- Minister expressed strong support for TGHN Nigeria



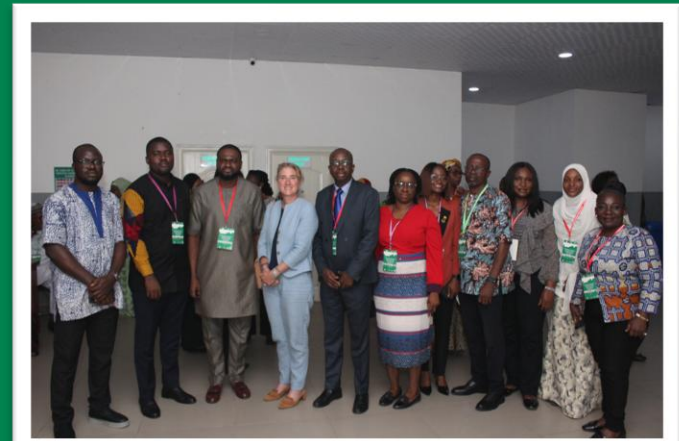
KEY OUTCOMES & NEXT STEPS

- 123 onsite attendees
- 60+ online participants
- Strong engagement across the healthcare & research community



LESSONS LEARNED

- **Successes:** High participation, government support, leveraged relationship
- **Hotspot:** Logistics, budget, negotiation, multitasking
- **Takeaways:** Don't promise to reimburse ground transport claim. Rather, declare a percentage/token to subsidize
- **Delegate** tasks and responsibility, follow up, get a partner, and let the partnering organization play some role or do somethings.
